

RESOLUTION OF PARLIAMENT EXTENDING THE DURATION OF THE TOURISM AND BUSINESS (SPECIAL INCENTIVES) ACT 2013, NO. 22 OF 2013 FOR TWO MORE YEARS COMMENCING ON 17TH DAY OF APRIL, 2016

WHEREAS section 16 of the Tourism and Business (Special Incentives) Act, 2013, No. 22 of 2013 provides that the Act continues in force for a period of two (2) years from the date of commencement and shall then expire unless its duration is extended by Resolution of Parliament;

WHEREAS the Cabinet by a decision dated 1st June, 2016 agreed to extend the duration of the Tourism and Business (Special Incentives) Act, 2013, No. 22 of 2013 for two more years, commencing on 17th April, 2016 to 16th April, 2018;

WHEREAS the Tourism and Business (Special Incentives) Act, 2013 commenced on 17th of April, 2014, the effective date on which it was published in the Gazette and expired on 16th April, 2016;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda that the Tourism and Business (Special Incentives) Act, 2013, No. 22 of 2013 be extended for a further period of two (2) years commencing on the 17th of April, 2016 until the 16th day of April, 2018.
