NOW, THEREFORE, I SIR RODNEY WILLIAMS, GCMG, Governor General, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, do hereby prorogue Parliament on The 9th day of January, 2018.

AND THE PRESIDENT of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the members of the Senate and of the House of Representatives, and all others whom it may concern are hereby required to take due notice hereof.

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 59(1) of the Constitution that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Antigua and Barbuda and shall begin at such time as the Governor General shall by Proclamation appoint.

NOW, THEREFORE, I SIR RODNEY WILLIAMS, GCMG, Governor General of Antigua and Barbuda, do hereby appoint the Parliament Building at Queen Elizabeth Highway in the city of St. John's as the place at which the Fifth Session of Parliament shall be held and 9:00 a.m. on the 18th day of January, 2018 as the time at which that session shall begin.
